## KNOW YOUR NEIGHBOUR



Community policing forums in Pretoria believe the key to fighting crime in the area may lie in getting to know those around you.

The CPF in Lyttelton Sector 4 have encouraged their members recently to take part in the **Know Your Neighbour** initiative.

The initiative is aimed at getting members acquainted with those closest to them.

1. In your time of need your neighbour can react the quickest by contacting the CPF or the police.
2. Your neighbour can also observe your property and keep an eye when you are on holiday.
3. He or she can take your mail inside, switch the lights on at night, and can join you in taking your dustbin out.
4. You can also encourage your neighbour to attend CPF meetings with you.
5. If he or she knows about any crime trends communicated at a recent CPF meeting you couldn't attend, he or she can share them with you.
6. Knowing your neighbour will help you identify who should be in your neighbourhood and notice suspicious people and vehicles.
7. Get to know your neighbour's domestic worker and gardener, you will notice when there is a possible intruder.
8. Know if your neighbour have small children/teenagers or are elderly people.
9. Knowing your neighbour, enables mutual assistance and sharing of information, creating a sense of community.

### Liquor Clamp down (courtesy of SAPS Lyttelton Liquor Officer)

Irresponsible consumption and parental control of liquor have been identified as being the main causes of crime:

- Cause of most vehicle accidents
- Exacerbating domestic violence
- In most cases, crime is committed under the influence of alcohol



Ministers very concerned about children consuming alcohol. Liquor may not be sold to or given to under 18's.

According to the Gauteng act, fines of R100,000 may be issued, but the fines according to the National Act is R1million, according to the severity of the offence. This is a very serious situation, problems with liquor premises selling to minors can be reported to Sgt McNish (0828228353). A press release is being drafted.

Public drinking is criminal offence. Alcohol may not be resold without a proper license.

Sgt McNish will address the community on 10 Sep for 10mins.

### Patrols & Operations

LS4 CPSF is working together with our neighbours LS6 to prevent crime within each other's borders.
